Office Memorandum

Subject: Revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes [Model 2].

The undersigned is directed to state that Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) *vide* their Office Memorandum No. 1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9th March, 2022 [Annexure A], have put in place, with effect from 1st April, 2022, revised procedure for flow of funds under the Central Sector Schemes of the Union Government.

- Models for implementation:
- i) Model-1: Implementation through Treasury Single Account (TSA):

While the Central Sector Schemes having annual outlay of more than Rs. 500 crore and implemented without involvement of State agencies, it shall be mandatory to implement such schemes through the Treasury Single Account (TSA) model. This will ensure that the funds of these schemes are released "Just-in-time", from the Consolidated Fund of India (CFI) to the beneficiaries/vendors. The Ministries/Departments may opt for Model-1 for other Central Sector Schemes too in consultation with RBI.

Model-2: Implementation through scheduled commercial banks:

The Central Sector Schemes having (a) annual outlay of less than Rs. 500 crore, or (b) the schemes are being implemented by agencies of the State Governments exclusively or in addition to the central agencies, or (c) other schemes not covered in Model-I, shall be implemented through Central Nodal Agencies (CNAs), which will open Central Nodal Account for each Scheme in a scheduled commercial bank.

3. The following two Central Sector Schemes of Department of Science and Technology, having annual outlay of less than Rs. 500.00 crore, are to be implemented as **Model-2**, as per details given below:

- Detailed procedure to be followed by the Department for implementation of the above two schemes, as per Model 2, are given in Annexure B.
- 5. The following may please be noted for smooth implementation of the revised procedure:-
- i) Technology Development Board (TDB) has been designated as Central Nodal Agency (CNA) for all the Implementing Agencies under both the schemes viz. 'Science and Technology Institutional and Human Capacity Building' and 'National Mission on Interdisciplinary Cyber physical System (NM-ICPS)'.
- ii) While the Central Nodal Account of TDB for the scheme, 'Science and Technology Institutional and Human Capacity Building' has been opened in Bank of Maharashtra, the Central Nodal Account of TDB for the scheme, 'National Mission on Interdisciplinary Cyber physical System (NM-ICPS)' has been opened in ICICI Bank.
- iii) All the Implement Agencies under both the above schemes, shall be treated as Sub Agencies (SA) of TDB.
- iv) Zero Balance Subsidiary Account shall be opened by SAs in Bank of Maharashtra in respect of the scheme, 'Science and Technology Institutional and Human Capacity Building' and ICICI Bank in respect of the scheme NM-ICPS.
